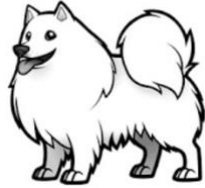

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

Traveling North:

Exit 134

- **South Gate:** Turn right at end of the exit ramp
- Take first left onto Fairgrounds

Exit 135

- **West Gate:** Turn right at end of exit ramp Turn right at first traffic light West Gate entrance on left
- **North Gate:** Turn right at end of exit ramp Proceed straight through traffic light North Gate entrance on right
- **East Gate:** Turn right at end of exit ramp Proceed straight through traffic light Proceed past North Gate entrance East Gate entrance on right Follow drive to Security Office

Traveling South:

Exit 135

- **West Gate:** Turn left at end of exit ramp Turn right at first traffic light West Gate entrance on left
- **North Gate:** Turn left at end of exit ramp Proceed straight through traffic light North Gate entrance on right
- **East Gate:** Turn left at end of exit ramp Proceed straight through traffic light Proceed past North Gate entrance East Gate entrance on right Follow drive to Security Office

1. Elements are divided into Levels "N"- "E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. Be sure to check the rules regarding the divisions. For these classes, dogs will only be searching the elements chosen.
2. Handler Discrimination. In Novice, Advanced, and Excellent, one glove must be provided by the handler. In Master level classes a personal item according to the rules for this level.
3. All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Nosework Trial Entry Form".
4. Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
5. Nosework events are open to all UKC registered breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number/Permanent Registration/Temporary Listing.
6. We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com/lt-numbers. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
7. The United Kennel Club complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require an accommodation, please contact the Event Chair or Secretary for this club's event.
